Methods/Criteria of Project Evaluation: The methods/criteria more often used for evaluating a project are (1) Simple rate of return (SRR) (2) Payback Period (PBP) (3) Benefit Cost Ratio (BCR) (4) Net present Value (NVP) or Net Present Worth (NPW) and (5) Internal Rate of Return (IRR).
